Attendance and Punctuality

Thank you for making sure your child is in school every day and on time. Remember that our minimum attendance target for all children is 96%.





Attending school **every day** impacts significantly on your child's learning and their attainment. Please see the table below that shows the number of lessons missed as the attendance rate falls.

Every day counts over the school year:

| Attendance during the school year | Equals this number of days absent | Meaning that approximately this number of lessons have been missed |
|-----------------------------------|-----------------------------------|--|
| 95% | 9 days | 50 lessons! |
| 90% | 19 days | 100 lessons! |
| 85% | 29 days | 150 lessons! |

Make sure your child is an *Oak Meadow* attendance H.E.R.O (Here, Every day, Ready and On Time) by arriving between 8:35 and 8:45am each morning.

Every minute counts over the school year:

5 minutes late each day = 3 days lost!

10 minutes late each day = 6.5 days lost!

15 minutes late each day = 10 days lost!

20 minutes late each day = 13 days lost!

30 minutes late each day = 19 days lost!

Did you know.....

The NHS Pharmacy First Service* enables children and adults to get convenient access to healthcare advice and treatment where appropriate.

The pharmacist will provide advice and, if clinically necessary, offer an NHS medicine to treat the condition (these medicines are supplied free of charge to children under 16 years, with the normal NHS prescription charge rules applying to people aged 16 or over), for seven common conditions without the potential delay of having to wait for a GP appointment.

Accessing the service may mean that the Pharmacy team can help children feel better and back to school as quickly as possible, as well as supporting parents/carers to also get better if they are unwell with one of the conditions covered under the service. There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their local Northwood Pharmacy with their child and ask for help under the service.

*NHS Pharmacy First Service: In pharmacies in England only. Subject to availability. Treatment is subject to suitability assessment. Normal NHS prescription charge rules apply.
