Geography and History Theme: Invaders (Anglo Saxons and Vikings)

During this term, we will be focusing on the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England. We will be researching how and why they invaded Britain, whilst also looking into how they lived and what made their lifestyle different to ours today. We will be looking at historical evidence and artifacts to help us understand and reconstruct life in this time period.
